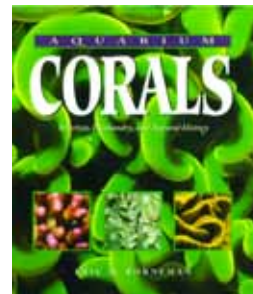


AQUARIUM CORALS

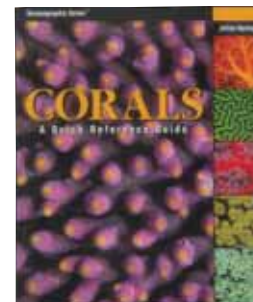


CORALS A QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

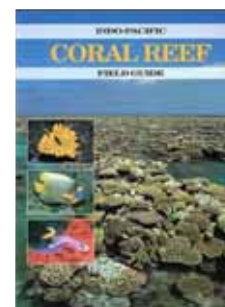


INDO-PACIFIC CORAL REEF FIELD GUIDE

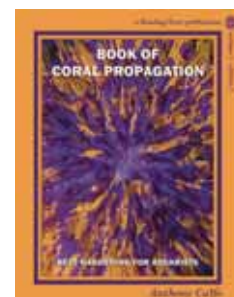
