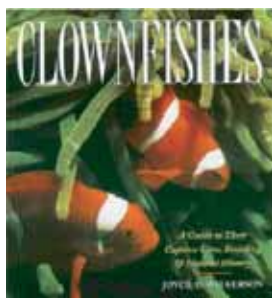


FIELD GUIDE TO ANEMONE FISHES AND THEIR HOST SEA ANEMONES

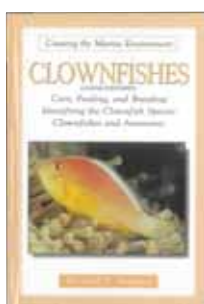


CONDITIONING SPAWNING & REARING OF FISH WITH EMPHASIS ON MARINE CLOWNFISH

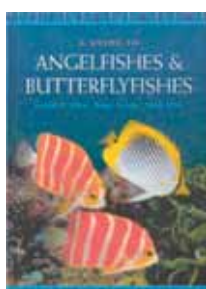


CLOWNFISHES (ANEMONEFISHES)
