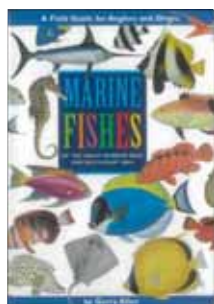

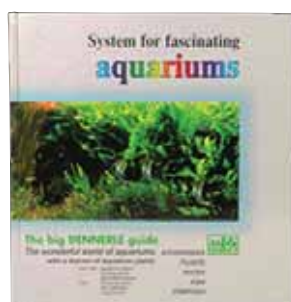

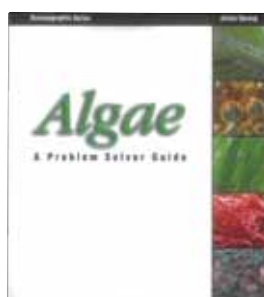


SYSTEM FOR FASCINATING AQUARIUMS
